

# M.A. Student Progress Flow-Chart

Below is a chart depicting student progress throughout the M.A. program.

## Full-time studies (a minimum of 3 terms of continuous registration -

*NOTE: funding covers 1 year of study ONLY)*

### Term 1

- **Two** (total of 6 credits)(**Field Specific Course requirement**) **Note:** A Total of **Six** 3.0 credit courses (total of 18 credits) should be completed by end of Term 2)
- **One** core course **or** an elective (total of 3 credits) **if core course is not taken**
- **Note:** Under special circumstances, MA students may take one 3.0 credit course from other graduate programs at York University to fulfill their elective requirement of 3.0 credits, only with the Graduate Program Director's approval

### Term 2

- HLTH 5050 3.0 (**Core Course requirement**)
- HLTH 5405 3.0 (**Core Course requirement**)
- **One** 3.0 credit (**Core Course**) if not taken in term 1.
- Establish a Supervisory Committee for the Major Research Paper
- Approval of the Principal Supervisor for the Major Research Paper
- Complete a proposal for the Major Research Paper

### Term 3

- Complete the Major Research Paper

## Part-time studies (a minimum of 6 terms of registration)

**Term 1 - HLTH 5050 3.0 (Core Course requirement); may** take a core/elective course

**Term 2 - HLTH 5405 3.0 (Core Course requirement); may** take a core/elective course

**Term 3 - One** 3.0 credit (**Core Course-student's choice**)

**Term 4 - One** 3.0 credit (**Field Specific Course requirement**); **OR** take **Two** (total of 6 credits (Field Specific Course requirement); **OR One** elective (total of 3.0 credits) if not completed in previous terms AND if only taking one Field Specific Course in Term 4)

**Note:** *Under special circumstances, MA students may take one 3.0 credit course from other graduate programs at York University to fulfill their elective requirement of 3.0 credits, only with the Graduate Program Director's approval*

**Term 5 - Complete** Field Specific Course requirement (total of 3.0 credits) if not completed in Term 4

**Note:** *A Total of Six 3.0 credit courses (total of 18 credits) should be completed by end of Term 5)*

- Establish a Supervisory Committee for the Major Research Paper
- Approval of the Principal Supervisor for the Major Research Paper
- Complete a proposal for the Major Research Paper

**Term 6 - Complete** the Major Research Paper
